Gun Violence Legislation – 115th Congress

Establishing the Select Committee on Gun Violence Prevention - H. Res. 367

A resolution to establish a Select Committee on Gun Violence Prevention to investigate the causes of mass shootings, methods to improve the background check system, loopholes allowing domestic abusers continued access to firearms, gun violence's effect on public health, and linkages between firearms and suicide.

Moments of Silence Are Not Enough – H. Res. 370

A resolution to require that a committee hearing be held whenever there is a moment of silence in the House for a tragedy involving gun violence.

Buyback Our Safety Act - H.R. 445

A bill to authorize the Department of Justice's Office of Justice Programs to establish a gun buyback grant program for state, local, and tribal law enforcement agencies.

Ghost Guns Are Guns Act – H.R. 1278

A bill to broaden the definition of "firearm" to include firearm assembly kits.

Gun Trafficking Prevention Act – H.R. 1475

A bill to make trafficking in firearms a crime.

Gun Violence Research Act - H.R. 1478

A bill to repeal the prohibition on the Department of Health and Human Services from sponsoring research on gun violence.

Gun Show Loophole Closing Act - H.R. 1612

A bill to require criminal background checks on all firearms transactions occurring at gun shows.

Disarm Hate Act – H.R. 2841

A bill to prohibit gun sales to a person who has been convicted of a misdemeanor hate crime or received an enhanced sentence for a misdemeanor because of hate or bias in its commission.

Prohibit Conversion of Semi-Automatic Weapons into Machine Guns – H.R. 3947

A bill to prohibit the manufacture, possession, sale, or transfer of devices designed to covert a semi-automatic weapon into the near equivalent of a fully automatic machine gun.

Keep Americans Safe Act – H.R. 4052

A bill to prohibit the transfer, importation, or possession of magazines able to hold more than 10 rounds of ammunition.

STOP (Students, Teachers, and Officers Preventing) School Violence Act – H.R. 4909

A bill to authorize funding for law enforcement programs that improve school safety.
